RULES for the Pennsylvania State High School Bowling Championships

1. Qualifying will be based on the results from the Eastern PA and Western PA Interscholastic Championships:
 - Eastern PAtop 6 boys teams, 6 girls teams, 12 boys singles, 12 girls singles
 - Western PAtop 6 boys teams, 6 girls teams, 12 boys singles, 12 girls singles
2. Any bowler, that is a member of a team that qualifies, is eligible to bowl for that team in team event as long as they are on their school's PIAA eligibility sheet. However, only SEVEN (7) bowlers total will be able to compete in the team event. That final roster must be finalized at check-in.
Changes to the Team roster may be made only during check-in (i.e., once application has been submitted only substitutions, not additions, can be made).
3. Team starting lineups will consist of five (5) bowlers.
4. All teams must consist of bowlers of the same sex, except for teams whose league rules allow for mixed teams. In that event, any mixed team will bowl in the boys division.
5. This tournament is USBC certified. However, only bowlers who are USBC sanctioned are eligible for USBC Youth Awards. Bowlers whose teams are registered with USBC High School Bowling are eligible for those specific awards. Bowlers need not be sanctioned to participate, nor do they have to pay a participation fee.
6. Tournament entry forms should be completed during the finals portion of Regionals.
7. Singles event will consist of six (6) games of qualifying across twelve (12) lanes. All six (6) games of qualifying will occur on Friday morning with the field being cut to the top five (5) after the qualifying session. Bowlers will move one pair to the right after each game.
8. Team event will consist of three (3) standard games followed by six (6) baker games. All games of qualifying will occur on Saturday morning with the field being cut to the top **four (4)** after the qualifying session.
9. Teams and singles' bowlers must check-in **30 minutes** before the beginning of any qualifying session.
10. In the team event during the standard portion, bowlers can be substituted once a game has begun. However, once a bowler is removed from a game, he/she may not return until the beginning of the next game. The game will be credited to the bowler who started the game. Also, no lineup order changes can be made, only substitutions. During the baker game portion, substitutions can be made at any time, including the middle of a frame. Once a bowler is removed, he or she may not return until the beginning of the next game. Coaches may change their lineup at the beginning of each game. At the beginning of each baker game, lineups may be changed.
11. In the event of an absent or vacant bowler, that bowler will receive 0 pins per frame.
12. In case of a tie in singles, a 9th and 10th frame rolloff will occur. In case of a tie in team event, a half-game modified baker game will break the tie (frames 6-10 only).
13. Top five (5) boys and top five (5) girls from the singles qualifying portion will advance to the stepladder finals. The format will be one-game winner moves on.
14. Top **four (4)** boys teams and top **four (4)** girls teams from the team qualifying portion will advance to **stepladder bracket**. The format will be best **2-out-of-3 baker games**, bowled on the same pair, alternating lanes after each game.
15. Bowling shoes will be provided free of charge.
16. NO use of cellular phones, or any electronic devices by any bowler, or coach **in the bowling establishment** during tournament play. No wearing smartwatches or fits.
17. No altering of the bowling ball surface once **practice** has concluded. Any bowler caught altering the surface of the bowling ball once play has started will be disqualified. Bowlers may clean their bowling ball with USBC approved cleaners during tournament play.
18. **For safety purposes, no bowler may apply any** foreign substance to the bowling approach or to their bowling shoes that may hinder other bowlers. Bowlers may use rosin and easy-slide on their hands. **If a product is questionable as to its legitimacy the decision of the tournament director will be final.**
19. DRESS CODE (for bowlers and all coaches): No denim of any kind. No jeans-style pockets or cargo pockets. The following items are prohibited: hats, t-shirts, sweat pants, warm-up/nylon pants, Capri pants, **yoga pants** or shorts as well as hanging jewelry (chains) and smart watches.

No Skirts or skorts unless medically required. Unless school issued, shirts must either be standard polo, classic retro, or mock-collar (one-inch thick). Unless school issued, large names are not permitted on the back of the shirt. This dress code will be strictly enforced.

20. Lewd or abusive language or behavior will not be tolerated, especially boisterous cheering or demonstrative “showboating” while on the approach. Any bowler caught doing so will be warned; a second warning could result in immediate disqualification.
21. All decisions of the tournament directors (Angelo Bordogna and Dana Brown), or on-site tournament manager, are final.
22. Coaches are responsible for submitting any USBC award scored earned during tournament play.
23. **No food or drink will be permitted to be brought into the bowling establishment.**
24. **Code of conduct for bowlers, coaches and spectators will be in effect.**

- 2nd place team event One 3-D plaque and seven individual plaques
- 3rd and 4th place team event One plaque and seven individual plaques
- 1st and 2nd high game team event.... individual plaque
- State All Star Team 5 boys and girls individual plaques
- 1st place singles event..... One 3-D plaque
- 2nd place singles events One 3-D plaque
- 3rd place singles event One plaque
- 4th and 5th place singles event..... One plaque
- 1st and 2nd high game singles..... individual plaques

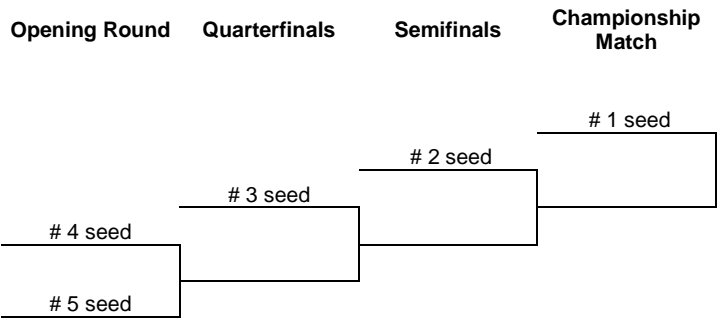

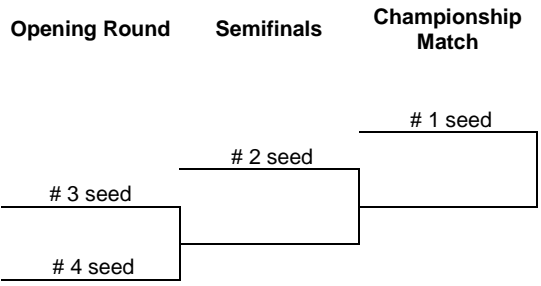
